RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1) Receive input from the public regarding the four (4) draft City Council district maps (Attachment A) selected for further discussion and consideration; and
- 2) Take such additional, related, action that may be desirable.

FISCAL IMPACT

None.

BACKGROUND

Montebello City Councilmembers are currently elected in “at-large” elections, in which each Councilmember is elected by the voters of the entire City. The City received a petition on March 15, 2021 alleging the City’s at-large election system violates the CVRA and requesting that the City voluntarily change its at-large system of electing Councilmembers to a district-based election system. In a by-district election system, a candidate for City Council must live in the district where the candidate wishes to represent, and only the voters of that district are entitled to vote to decide who their representative will be.

DISCUSSION

The CVRA was enacted in 2001 to implement the California constitutional guarantees of equal protection and the right to vote. Under the CVRA, a city is required to hold at least

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two (2) public hearings prior to the drawing of draft City Council district maps, and at least two (2) public hearings after the draft City Council district maps are drawn.

The City Council has held public hearings on October 13, 2021, November 13, 2021, February 9, 2022, February 23, 2022, and April 9, 2022, where the City Council reduced the number of potential draft City Council district maps from six to four.

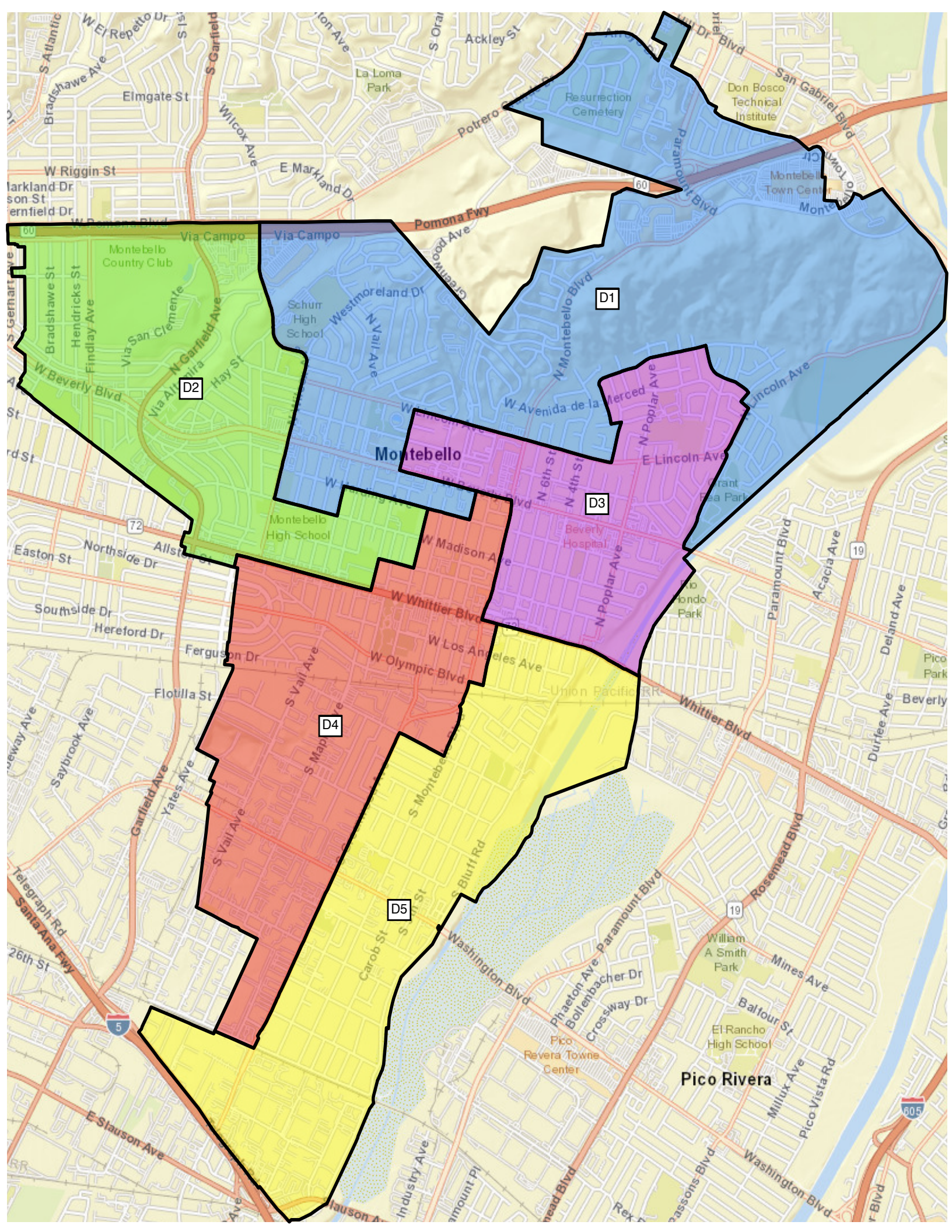
SUMMARY

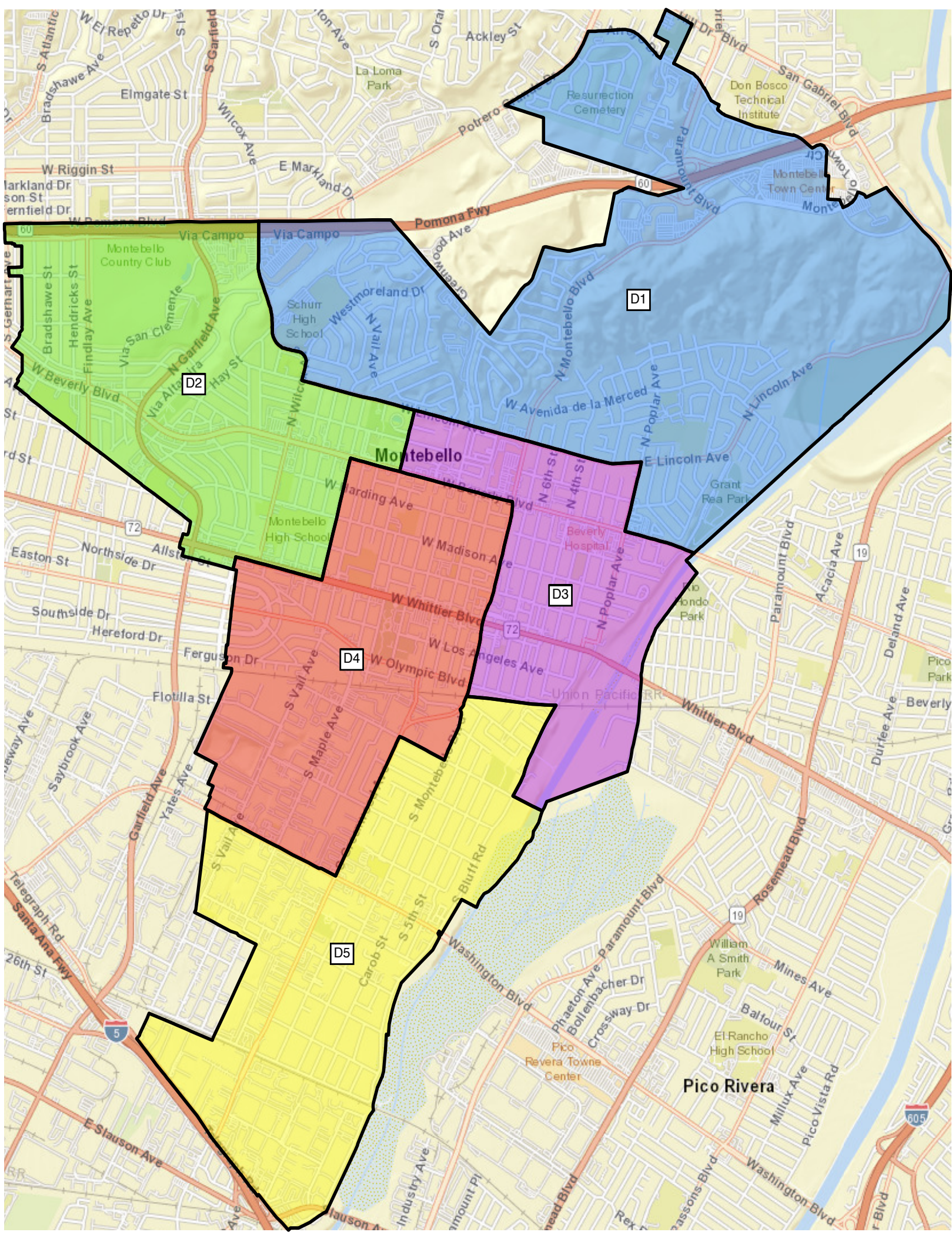

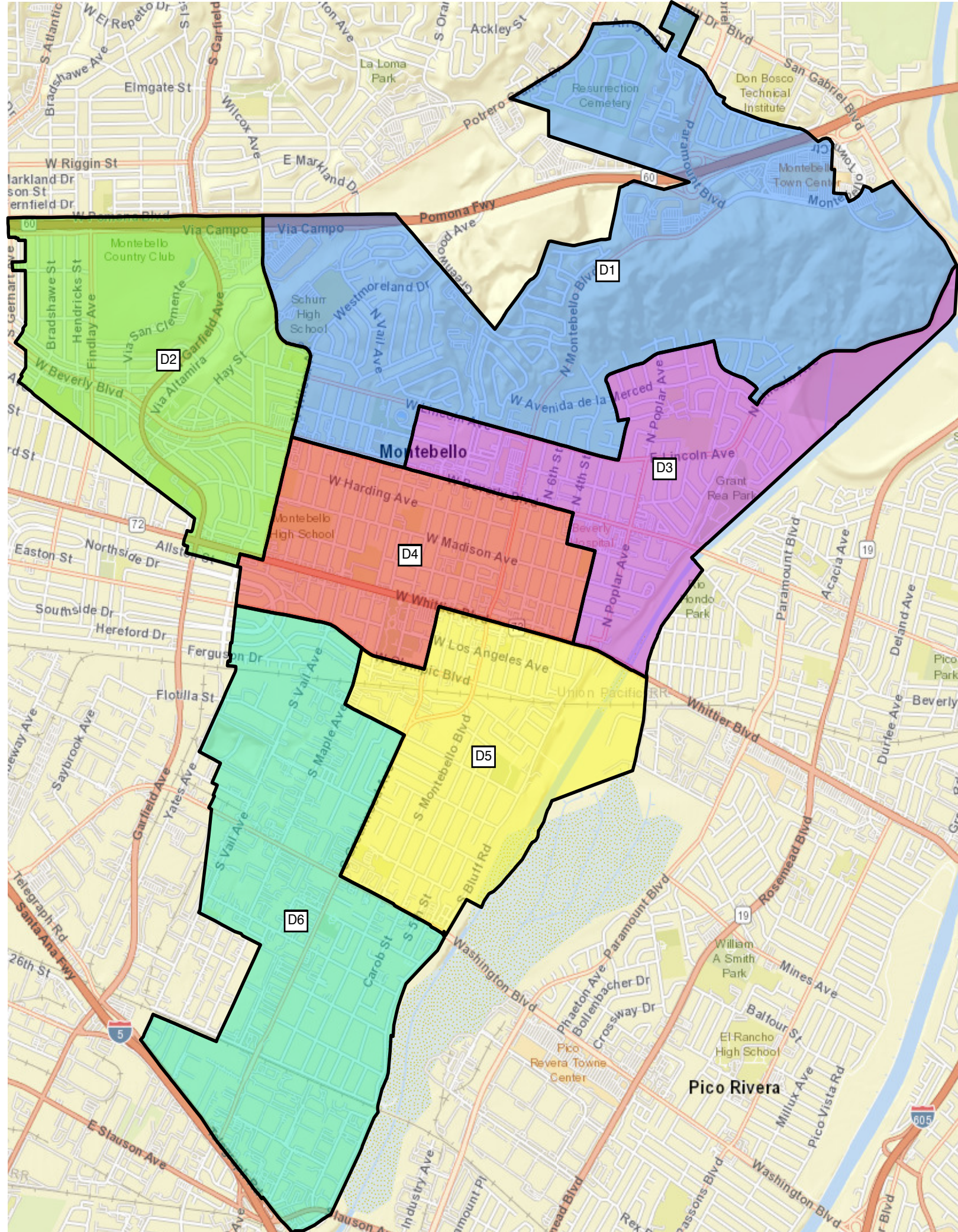

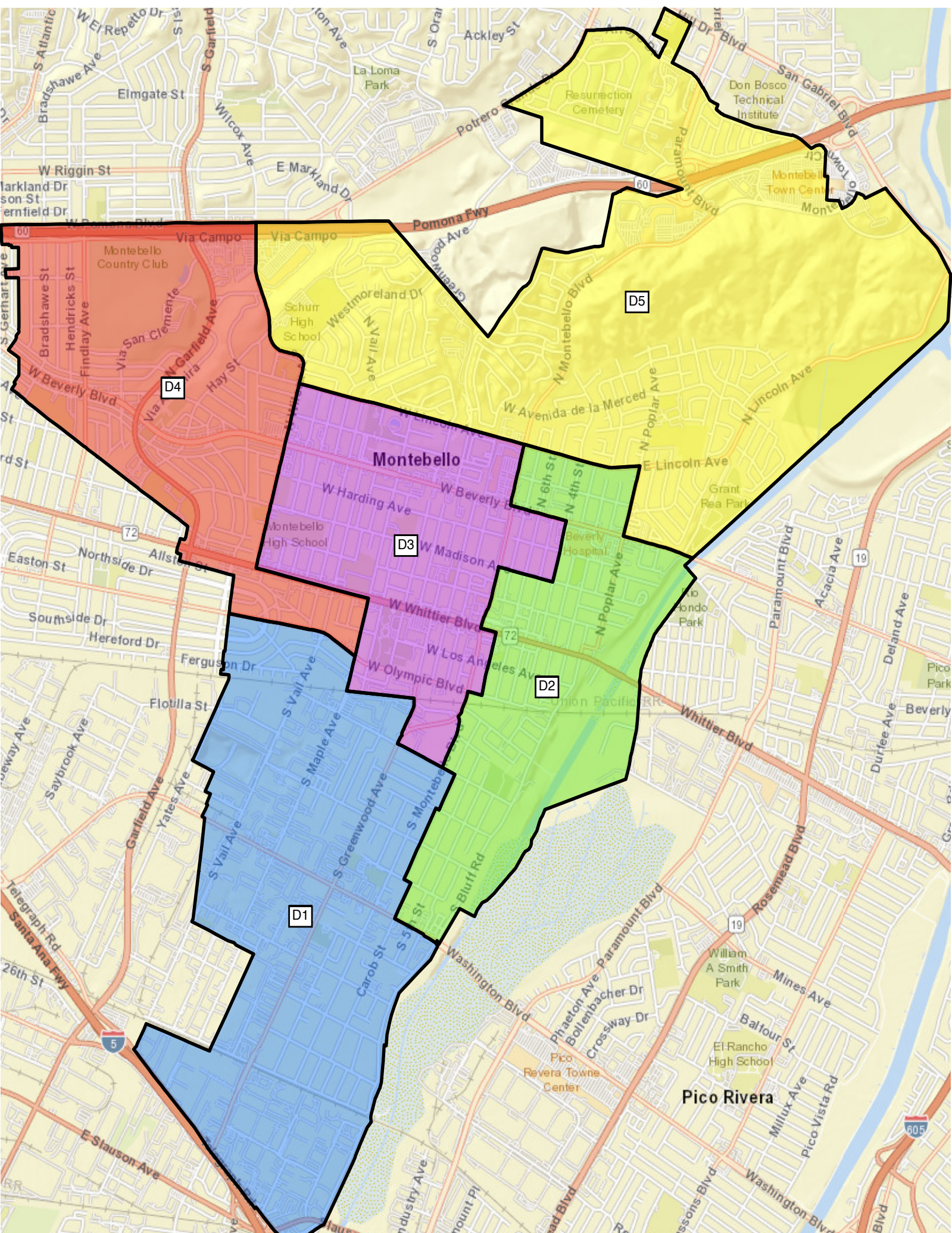
