**PUBLIC HEARING**

1. **FIRST READING AND INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 2461 AMENDING THE GENERAL PLAN AND ZONING DESIGNATION (CASE NO. "PC-2022-0004-GPA-ZC-SPR") FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 844 SOUTH GREENWOOD AVENUE TO ALLOW THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWELVE (12) RESIDENTIAL UNITS**

**RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:**

1. Conduct Public Hearing and uphold the Planning Commission's recommendation to approve General Plan Amendment (GPA) and Zone Change (ZC) Case No. PC-2022-0004-GPA-ZC-SPR to amend the General Plan Designation from Low Density Residential to High Density Residential and change the zoning designation from R-1 to R-3 to allow the development of twelve (12) residential units, and make related findings that the proposed project is consistent with the Montebello General Plan; and
2. Waive First Reading and Introduction of Ordinance No. 2461 approving a GPA and ZC (Case No. PC-2022-0004-GPA-ZC-SPR) for the property located at 844 S. Greenwood Avenue ("Project Site"); and
3. Find and Determine the GPA and ZC to be statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") under section 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense Exemption) considering that CEQA only applies to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. No physical changes will occur as a result of the proposed General Plan Amendment and Zone Change; and
4. Take such additional, related action that may be desirable.

*Monica Mercado-Rodriguez, Planning Manager, presented a staff report request to amend the general plan for the property at 844 S. Greenwood Avenue, allowing the construction of twelve (12) residential units. Planning Manager Mercado-Rodriguez explained the request to change the general plan designation from low-density residential to high-density residential, and the zoning to allow the construction of the 12 units. Said recommendations have been approved by the Planning Commission and require City Council approval. Furthermore, she provided an overview of the proposed site plans, both the west and east portion, including the renderings.*

*James Enriquez, Director of Public Works, and Jake Torres, Senior Accountant Executive from Alliance Building Solutions, Inc. provided a PowerPoint presentation of the Energy Efficiency Project. The presentation included: the scope of the project, which consisted of Transit Facilities, City Hall, and the Aquatic Center; the HVAC mechanical scope, including controls and pumping scope; the existing HVAC infrastructure; roofing upgrades at the Transit Center, City Hall, and Aquatic Center; and an overview of the indoor air quality products and solar system.*

*Mayor Pro Tem Peralta asked clarifying questions regarding solar financing and funding programs and how this project will incorporate union labor; her questions were addressed by Alliance Building Solutions, Inc. Senior Accountant Executive*

Torres.

*Re: Unlawful Appointment to Fill Perceived Council Vacancies*

I write on behalf of our clients, registered voters and taxpayers residing in the City of Montebello. It has come to our attention that the Montebello City Council (the “Council”) intends on appointing two new members to the Council, based on its view that the size of the Council is seven seats and thus there are two vacancies. That view is erroneous – based on a poorly crafted ordinance (Ordinance No. 2451) that contradicts itself, and an interpretation of that ordinance that would render it in violation of the Government Code. Please regard this communication as notice pursuant to any applicable law or rule concerning any administrative remedy.

The contradiction of Ordinance No. 2451, particularly triggered by the present circumstances, begins with the second sentence of Section 2(G):

In addition to the five (5) Councilmembers to be newly elected in the November 2022 election, the two (2) incumbent at-large Councilmember seats will remain in office and will continue to serve as a Councilmember until the expiration of their term, forming a temporary seven (7) member legislative body.

This sentence inexplicably switches from “Councilmembers” to “Councilmember seats.” It appears this is simply a typo, as councilmembers “serve” and may “remain in office,” “councilmember seats” do neither.

With that typo resolved, Ordinance 2451, and specifically the sentence reproduced

above, addresses the present situation. Since the “the expiration of the[] term[s]” of the “two (2) incumbent at-large Councilmembers” has now occurred (by virtue of those councilmembers vacating those seats), the “temporary seven (7) member legislative body” ceases. While this result has occurred before the next two sentences anticipate, which would otherwise contradict the sentence duplicated above, that does not change the outcome – the council is again five (5) members. Therefore, there are no vacancies to fill – the transition to a district-based council is complete.

This interpretation, and the fortuitous district election in 2022 of the two remaining at-large councilmembers resulting in the expiration of their at-large terms, also saves Ordinance No. 2451 from conflicting with the Government Code. Government Code section 34886 authorizes only the adoption of certain council compositions without a vote of the electorate “in furtherance of the purposes of the California Voting Rights Act”: “a) By districts in five, seven, or nine districts [or] ... (c) By districts in four, six, or eight districts, with an elective mayor.” (Gov’t Code §§ 34871 and 34886). The Government Code does not authorize the temporary adoption of a seven-member council with two at-large seats, followed by a reduction of the size of the council some time later back to a five-member council. In fact, the reduction of the size of a city council is generally regarded as retrogressive and antithetical to voting rights; so it is hard to imagine how Government Code section 34886 could allow such an action. (See U.S. Dept. of Justice Voting Determination Letter to Pitt County Schools, Apr. 30, 2012.) Certainly, the sort of appointment that the Montebello City Council seems intent on, i.e. without any election, is undemocratic, and thus inconsistent with the purposes of the CVRA – the right to vote and equal protection. (See Elec. Code §14031.) Interpreting Ordinance No. 2451 to now allow the seated councilmembers to appoint two new councilmembers, would conflict with the Government Code. Montebello is a general law city, so to the extent the Government Code conflicts with Ordinance No. 2451, the Government Code controls. (See Cal. Const. Art. XI sec. 7.)

I trust you will recognize the wisdom and desirability of regarding the Council as having five seats due to the expiration of the two at-large-elected incumbents’ terms. If, however, you regard the Council as having seven seats until November 2024, despite our explanation of the law, we believe you will have additional problems that prevent the appointment of anyone to the Council.

Members of the Montebello City Council,

My name is Dr. Alberto “Al” Pimentel Jr and I am a proud resident of the City of Montebello for the past 23 years (9 of those years as a homeowner). I am also a Professor of Sociology for the Los Angeles Community College District for the past 10 years and an active participant in my local union AFT 1521, the California Teachers Association (Community College Association), and most notably, the National Education Association. My experience as a sociologist and member of several well-respected and well-known unions has largely shaped my understanding of diversity, equity, and inclusion in the workplace and community. As most of you know, from one-on-one conversations, I am a strong ally of the Asian American-Pacific Islander (AAPI) community and in Montebello’s most recent transition from an at-large to a district-based election system, I was a vocal and consistent advocate for our city’s adherence to the California Voting Rights Act of 2001. In fact, on multiple occasions, I spoke to most of you regarding our city’s insufficient outreach and relative exclusion of the AAPI community. That being said, I am submitting this letter to continue my advocacy for the AAPI and the AAPI community’s representation in our local government. Specifically, I am deeply concerned about our city council’s failure to actively recruit and consider a member of the AAPI community to one (or both) of the vacant at-large seats on the city council (based on the initial nominations, please reference the 1/11/2023 City Council Meeting, specifically at the 3 hour and 36 minute mark).

The AAPI community represents more than 14% of Montebello’s population and in the newly developed “District 1”, the AAPI community makes up nearly 34% of the population. The city received a notification of CVRA violations over a year ago and despite the transition to a district-based election system, we did not have a candidate who self-identifies as a member of the AAPI community in any of the 5 districts (I understand this is beyond your control). The city council’s desire to fill the two open at-large seats via appointment provides a wonderful and historic opportunity to develop a more inclusive city council that properly reflects our city’s demographics. I encourage our city’s leaders to seize the moment, do what is right and just, and fulfill the intentions of the CVRA by adhering to democratic values and strengthening our commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion.

Lastly, I understand that the city council recently announced an application process for the two at-large seats. Just as Mayor Pro Tem Peralta was excited to nominate two candidates of her own, I am hopeful that the same enthusiasm and efforts are exercised to identify and encourage members of the AAPI community to apply by the deadline.
