Councilmember Melendez motioned, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Peralta, that Item No's. 6-9 and 11, be approved; the motion passed unanimously.

5. TREASURER'S REPORT FOR THE QUARTER ENDING JUNE 30, 2023

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Receive and file the Quarterly Treasurer's Report for the quarter ending June 30, 2023 (Fourth Quarter).

City Treasurer Matanga provided a presentation of the item.

Mayor Pro Tem Peralta motioned, seconded by Councilmember Melendez; the motion passed unanimously.

6. WAIVE SECOND READING AND ADOPT ORDINANCE NO. 2464 AMENDING THE ZONING DESIGNATION (CASE NO. "PC-2022-0003-ZC-SPR-TPM") FOR THE PROPERTIES LOCATED AT 608, 612, and 616 HART PLACE TO ALLOW THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIXTEEN (16) RESIDENTIAL UNITS

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Waive Second Reading and Adopt Ordinance No. 2464 approving Zone Change (ZC) Case No. PC-2022-0003-ZC-SPR-TPM as well as the related Development Agreement (No. 01-22) and Density Bonus Agreement between the City of Montebello and San Giorgio, LLC to amend the zoning designation for the properties located at 608, 612, and 616 Hart Place ("Project Site") from C-R (Commercial Restricted) to C-R-HOO (Commercial Restricted with the Housing Opportunity Overlay) to allow the development of sixteen (16) residential units, and make related findings that the proposed project is consistent with the Montebello General Plan; and
2. FIND and DETERMINE the ZC, Development Agreement, and Density Bonus Agreement to be statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") under section 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense Exemption) considering that CEQA only applies to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. No physical changes will occur as a result of the proposed Zone Change, Development Agreement, and Density Bonus Agreement; and
3. Take such additional, related action that may be desirable.

Councilmember Melendez motioned, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Peralta; the motion passed unanimously.

7. APPROVAL OF A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE UPPER LOS ANGELES RIVER (ULAR) WATERSHED MANAGEMENT GROUP

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Approve the MOA with the Upper Los Angeles River (ULAR) Watershed Group for Fiscal Years 2023-24 through 2025-26 (Attachment A); and

2. Amend the Fiscal Year 2023-24 budget increasing appropriations by \$27,721 in Account No. 229-30-315-6040.10 (Measure W, Public Works, Stormwater, Outside Contracts); and
3. Take such additional, related action that may be desirable.

Councilmember Melendez motioned, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Peralta; the motion passed unanimously.

8. APPROVE AGREEMENT NO. 4123 WITH JOHNSON CONTROLS, INC. FOR CITYWIDE HVAC MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Award Professional Service Agreement No. 4123 (Attachment A) to Johnson Controls, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$320,000 over two (2) years; and
2. Authorize the City Manager to execute the Professional Service Agreement, on behalf of the City; and
3. Take such additional, related action that may be desirable.

Councilmember Melendez motioned, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Peralta; the motion passed unanimously.

9. REQUEST TO ISSUE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) NO. 24 – 3 FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT LEGAL SERVICES AND PROCESS INVOICES FOR FUTURE RELATED SERVICES

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Authorize issuing a Request for Proposals No. 24-3 (RFP) for Police Department Legal Services; and
2. Authorize payment of future invoices from the Law Office of Jones & Mayer for legal services during Fiscal Year 2023 – 24 in an amount not to exceed \$4,000; and
3. Take such additional, related action that may be desirable.

Councilmember Melendez motioned, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Peralta; the motion passed unanimously.

10. AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 TABLE OF ORGANIZATION/MASTER POSITION CONTROL TO ADD EIGHTEEN (18.0) "FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC" FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Amend the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Table of Organization/Master Position Control to add eighteen (18) "Firefighter/Paramedic" Full-Time Equivalent Positions; and
2. Take such additional, related action that may be desirable.

Mayor Torres stated that he was concerned about the long-term liability of the plan and suggested continuing Item No. 10 to the first meeting in September to allow further information and discussion.

Councilmember Melendez motioned, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Peralta; the motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Jimenez spoke in support of honoring Jerry Griffin during Suicide Prevention Week. She requested council consensus to direct staff to commemorate personnel who had died of suicide during September. Consensus was received.

Councilmember Jimenez requested council consensus to direct staff to provide a report of violent crimes per district. Mayor Pro Tem Peralta requested to include reported thefts. Consensus was received.

Councilmember Jimenez requested an update on the project. Acting City Manager Salazar stated that the vendors had been suspended until the Council provided further direction. Councilmember Jimenez requested council consensus to continue the process of the golf course remnant parcel.

Mayor Pro Tem Peralta stated she did not support using the remnant parcel for high-density housing. Instead, it should be left as green space since there's a lack thereof.

Councilmember Melendez stated that he is concerned about potential litigation because three firms submitted proposals for the project. He agreed with Mayor Pro Tem Peralta's recommendation and spoke in favor of bringing the item forward for further discussion for transparency with the community and vendors.

Councilmember Tamayo asked clarifying questions regarding the Request for Proposal (RFP). Director of Planning and Community Development Joseph Palombi provided clarification.

Mayor Torres agreed with Mayor Pro Tem Peralta that the golf course parcels should be used as green space. He requested to amend Councilmember Jimenez's request by directing staff to rescind the RFP for high-density housing and instead issue an RFP for green space.
