7. MONTEBELLO MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE RENOVATION PROJECT PHASE 3 (CP NO. 894-3) – AWARD OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Find that the bid received from J-Squared General Contractors, Inc. is non-responsive and reject the bid; and
2. Award a construction contract for the Montebello Municipal Golf Course Renovation Project Phase 3 (CP No. 894-3) in the amount of \$10,144,000 to Robert Clapper Construction Services, Inc. dba R.C. Construction Services; and
3. Authorize the Director of Public Works to review and approve change orders within a five percent (5%) contingency of the contract amount; and
4. Authorize the City Manager to execute the Contract Agreement (Attachment A) with R.C. Construction Services, on behalf of the City; and
5. Find that the requested "Changes in Work" for Phase 1 (CP No. 894-1) (Attachment B) have no significant effect on the environment and approve the changes in the aggregate amount of \$819,500. The adjusted contract amount with Los Angeles Engineering, Inc. is \$5,913,500; and

6. Find that the requested “Changes in Work” for Phase 2 (CP No. 894-2) (Attachment C) have no significant effect on the environment and approve the changes in the aggregate amount of \$1,823,850. The adjusted contract amount with American Landscape, Inc. is \$11,488,508; and
7. Approve Amendment No. 3 to Agreement No. 3937 with SPORTFIVE Golf, LLC (Attachment D) for additional architectural and engineering design services in the amount not-to-exceed \$362,487; and

8. AWARD PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT NO. 4125, TO TENNANT SALES AND SERVICE COMPANY, FOR SCRUBBER AND SWEEPER REPLACEMENT REQUEST FOR QUOTE NO. Q-23-1

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the City Council:

Authorize the Acting City Manager to execute professional service agreements with ATI Restoration LLC., Mr. Rooter Plumbing, and Custom Craft Flooring for the repair of the Montebello Police Department to remediate the damage caused by water intrusion, in a total aggregate amount of \$300,000; and
4. Amend the Fiscal Year 2023-24 budget by increasing appropriations by \$300,000 in Account No.100-30-510-6040.60 (General Fund, Public Works, Facilities Maintenance, Other Contract Services-Building Maintenance/ Repairs); and
